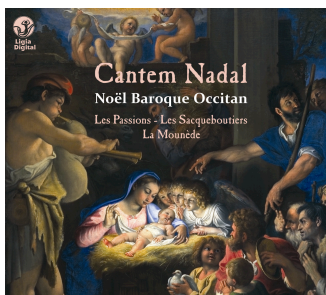


Presentation

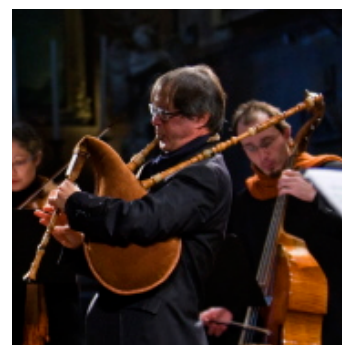
